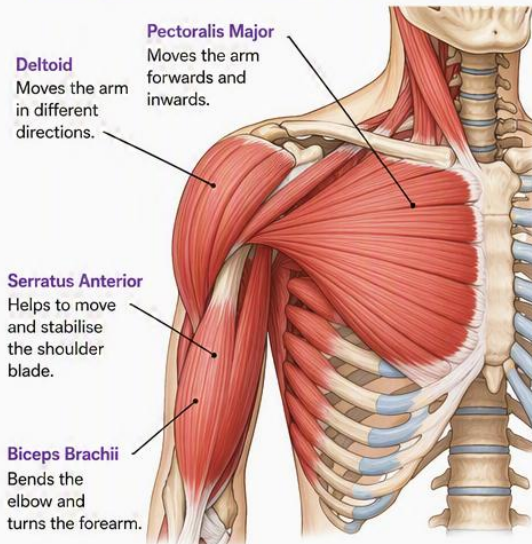


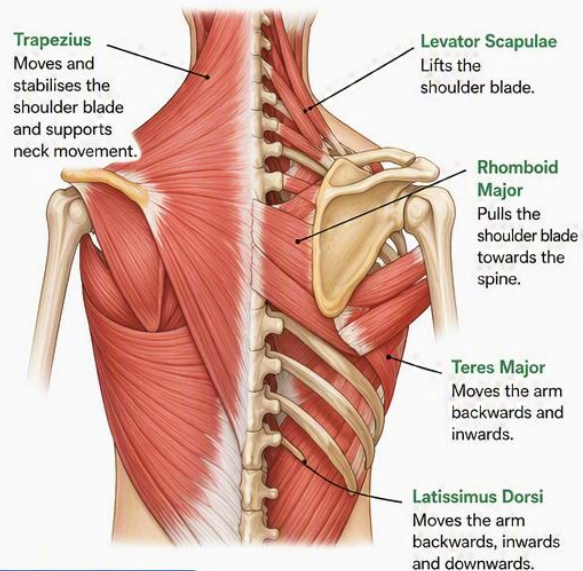

MUSCLES OF THE SHOULDER GIRDLE, NECK AND SKULL

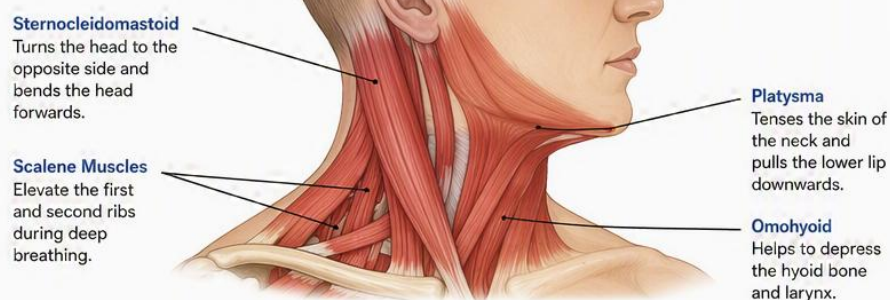
SHOULDER GIRDLE – ANTERIOR VIEW



SHOULDER GIRDLE – POSTERIOR VIEW

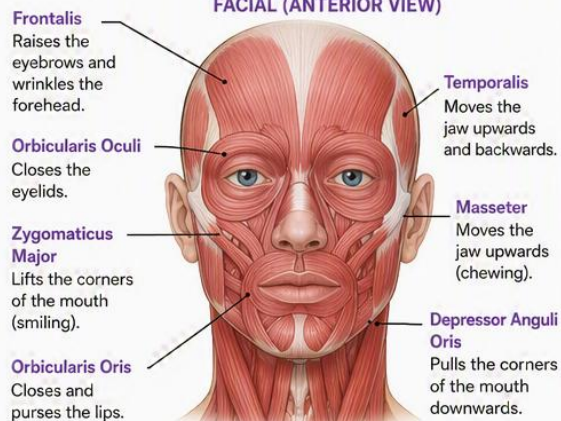


NECK – ANTERIOR / LATERAL VIEW

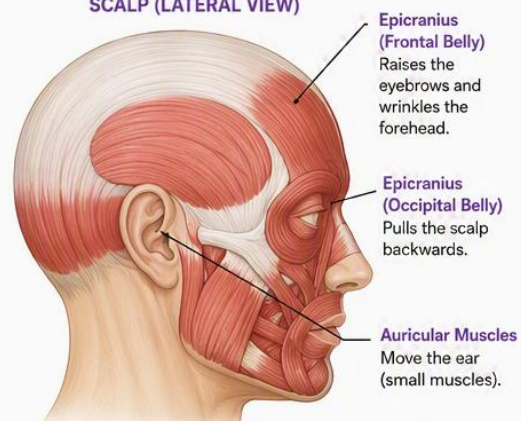


MUSCLES OF THE SKULL – FACIAL AND SCALP VIEW

- The shoulder girdle muscles move and stabilise the shoulder joint.
- Neck muscles support head movement and assist with breathing.
- Facial and scalp muscles are mainly responsible for expression.
