

4	B	Layering – Hair cut shorter on the outside and longer towards the interior
5	F	Over-direction – Moving hair away from its natural fall before cutting
6	G	Uniform Layer – Hair cut to the same length throughout the head
7	I	Blunt Cut – A haircut where all hair ends at the same level
8	H	Texturising – Technique used to remove bulk and add movement
9	A	Tapering – Establishes the shape and length that guide the rest of the haircut <i>(or use "hair gradually shortening in length" if teaching tapering specifically)</i>
10	J	Perimeter – The outer edge or outline of a haircut
