5	Patch Test	G – A test carried out when required to identify possible sensitivity or reaction to a product.
6	Ventilation	J – The movement of fresh air through the treatment area.
7	Hygiene	I – Practices used to reduce contamination and the risk of cross-infection.
8	Exfoliation	H – The removal of dead skin cells from the surface of the skin.
9	Aftercare	A – The care and advice given to the client following treatment.
10	UV Radiation	M – Radiation from the sun or artificial sources that can damage the skin.
11	Contra-Action	K – An unwanted reaction that may occur during or after a treatment.
12	Moisturising	L – Helps maintain the condition and appearance of the skin and tan.
13	Spray Tan	B – A temporary cosmetic treatment that gives the skin a bronzed appearance.
14	Disposable Equipment	N – Items designed for single use to help maintain hygiene.
15	Skin Preparation	O – Preparing the skin appropriately before applying the tanning solution.
